The Portage Soccer Club began in 1985. Starting with only four boys teams playing in the West Michigan Youth Soccer Association, today PSC is one of the largest clubs in WMYSA fielding both boys and girls teams from U9 all the way to U19.

Although the Club has changed in size over the years, our philosophy of emphasizing player development over winning has remained the same, and our teams have performed very well on the field in terms of both skill and results.
